
A network of organizations working to increase the value and practice of service learning from kindergarten through postsecondary in the Greater Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky area.

Service learning is a teaching strategy that empowers students to solve problems that affect the local or global community. It is a student driven process—students (guided by their teachers) learn about a particular issue, place or problem; then figure out how to make a positive impact. Students identify the issue and work to come up with solutions. Service learning allows students to uncover their own strengths and abilities in order to make real change.

PRAIRIE produces an arts-based service learning program for high school students called New Voices. Each New Voices program pairs students with individuals from one community organization with the goal of bridging socio-economic, age, racial or other barriers in our community. Students, in collaboration with their partners, photograph sites, activities or other subjects of interest and work together to create an exhibit, installation or publication at the conclusion of each program. The final presentation also includes student and partner reflections which represent their shared understanding of significant community issues. Programs last an average of ten weeks and run in the fall, winter and spring.
